



UPDATE ON THE WALKING CHALLENGE!

We will combat this by having a weekly rota set up in the previous week to allocate volunteers to the walking bus. This will be communicated by email and a dedicated WhatsApp group. So, even if you are only able to commit to one walking bus a term or even a year, I would ask if you could volunteer. It would be amazing if we could crew the walking bus every day but I will be happy with once a week!
